- Photography and video used to create presentation about building of canal
- Creation of historic documentary, using aerial photography and videography



Situation:

- A historically significant project that built a new 23-mile long concrete canal parallel to the existing Canal
- The purpose of making a parallel canal was to eliminate water seepage going into Mexico
- Water is a scarce commodity and the U.S. needed to take necessary steps to ensure an adequate water supply
- The All American Canal Lining Project was one of the largest water conservation projects in the U.S.
